Larry Bawden is a co-founder of Jadoo Power, an innovative supplier of portable fuel cells, and Q1 NanoSystems, a next-generation photovoltaics provider.

Jadoo (Hindi for "magic"), founded in 2001, developed a hydrogen fuel cell system and became the only manufacturer licensed to ship commercial hydrogen fuel cells by air cargo. In 2003, Jadoo was one of only seven companies invited to the White House to demonstrate alternative energy sources.

Q1 NanoSystems, founded in 2005, is a startup dedicated to building the next generation of solar cells.

In the past, Larry has held senior management positions in energy and aerospace companies dealing with technology, business development, investment management, corporate strategy and engineering.

Larry is a co-inventor on five pending energy patents. Mr. Bawden serves on Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Technical Advisory Committee (HTAC), which advises the Department of Energy on policy issues.

He is also the recipient of the "Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year 2006 Award" for Emerging Markets, Northern California, and of a Group Achievement award from NASA. **ETL**

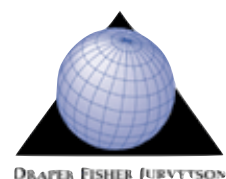
